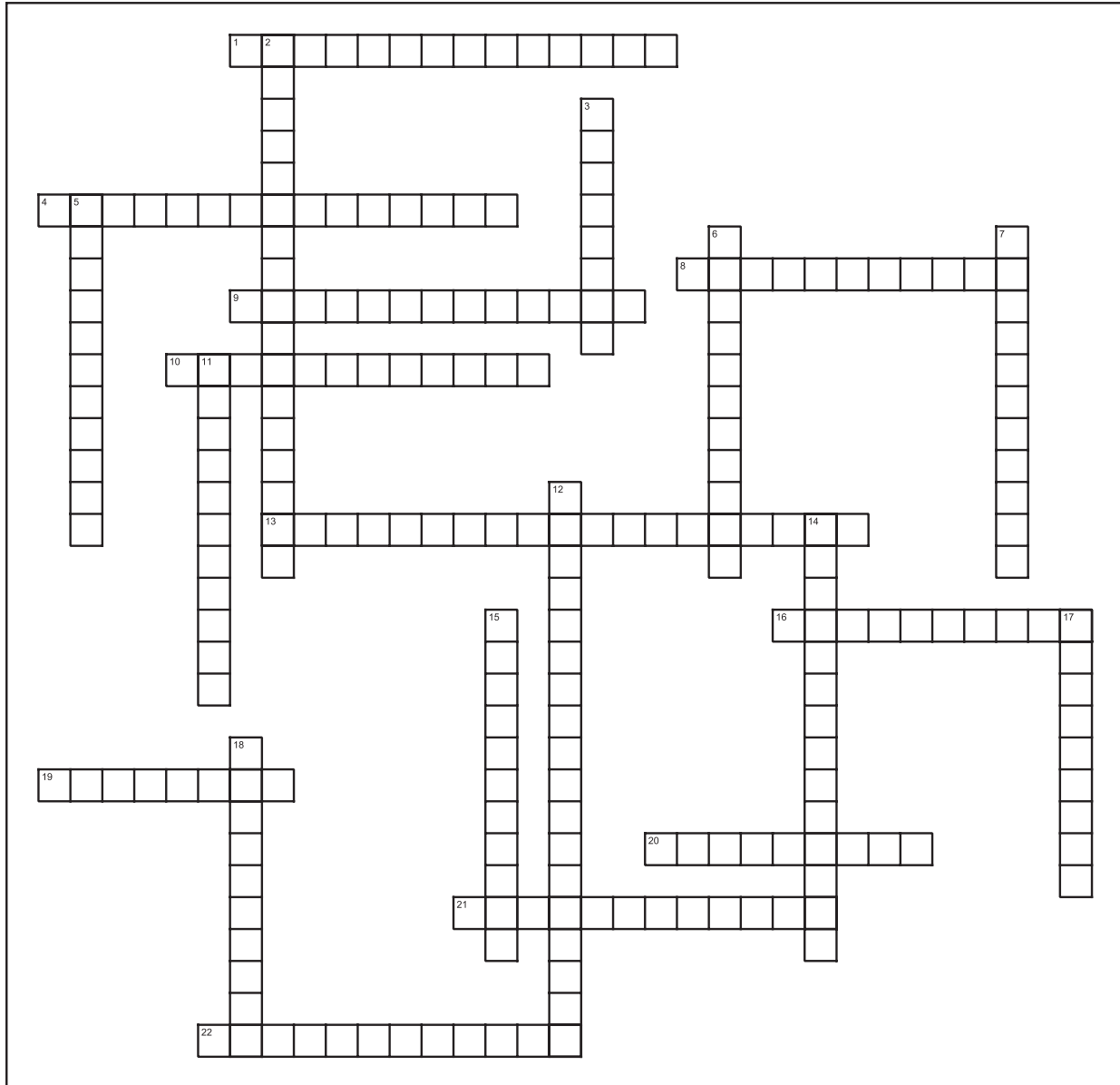


# NEW YORK CITY CROSSWORD



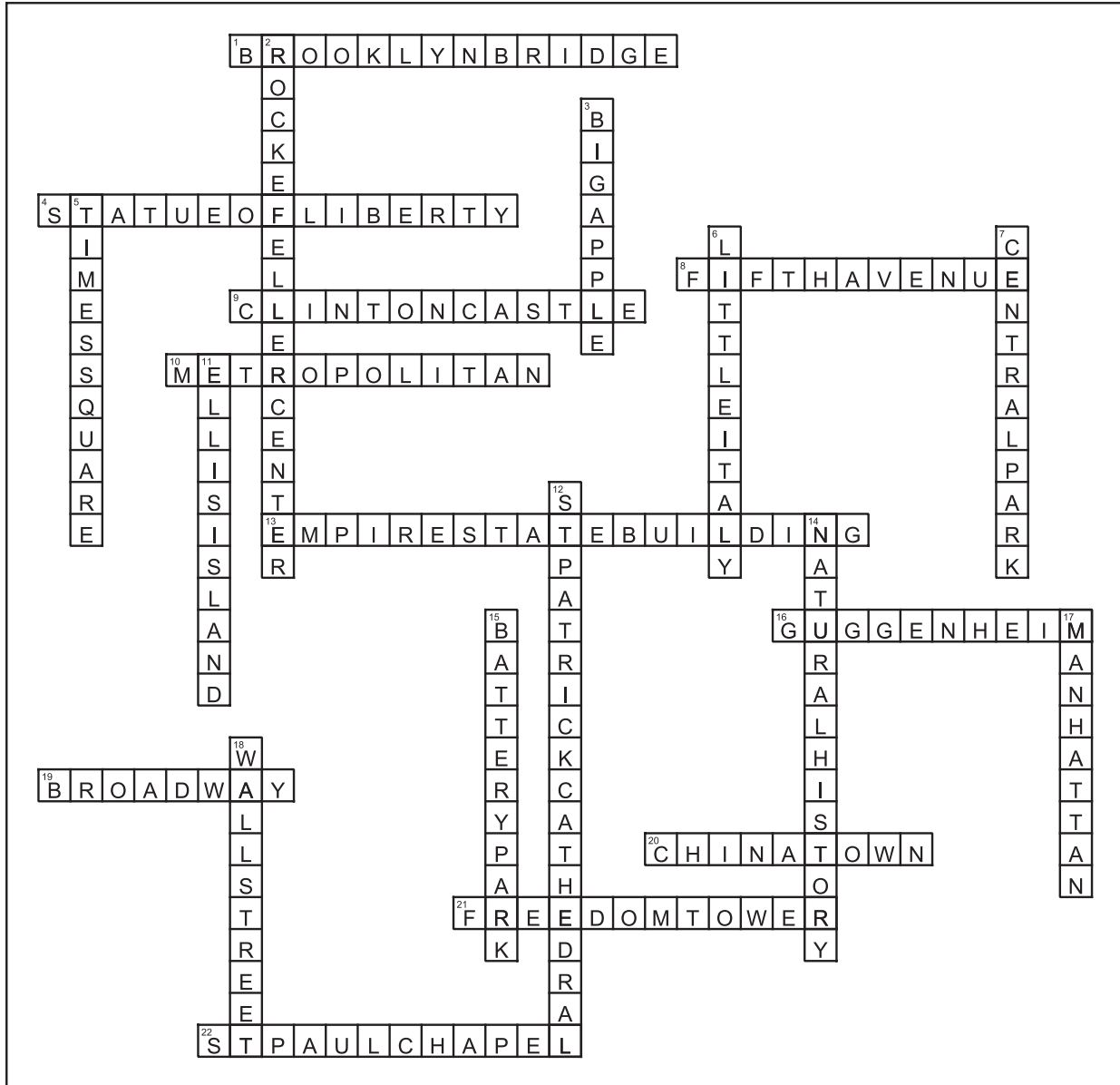
## ACROSS
