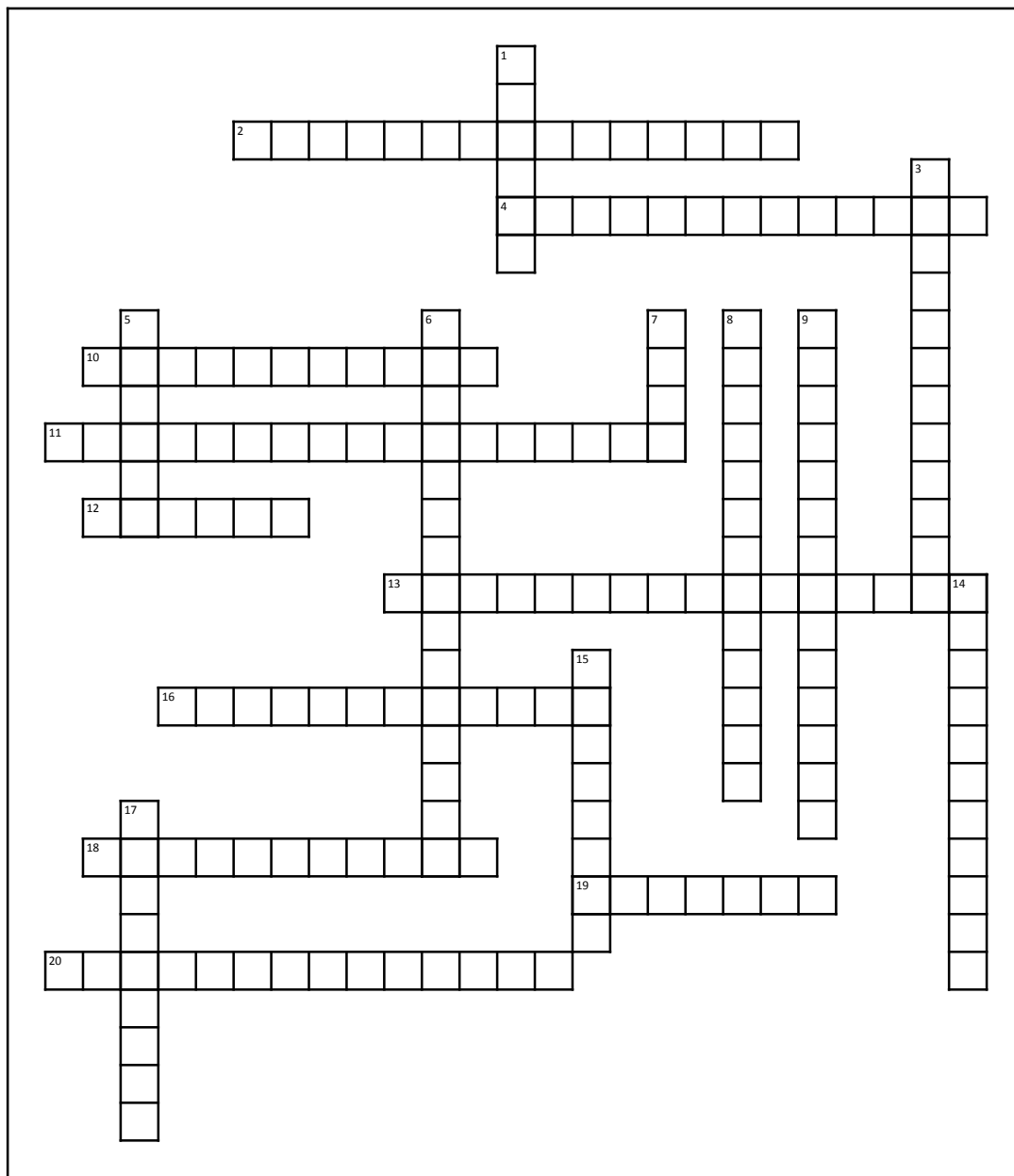


PHILADELPHIA CROSSWORD



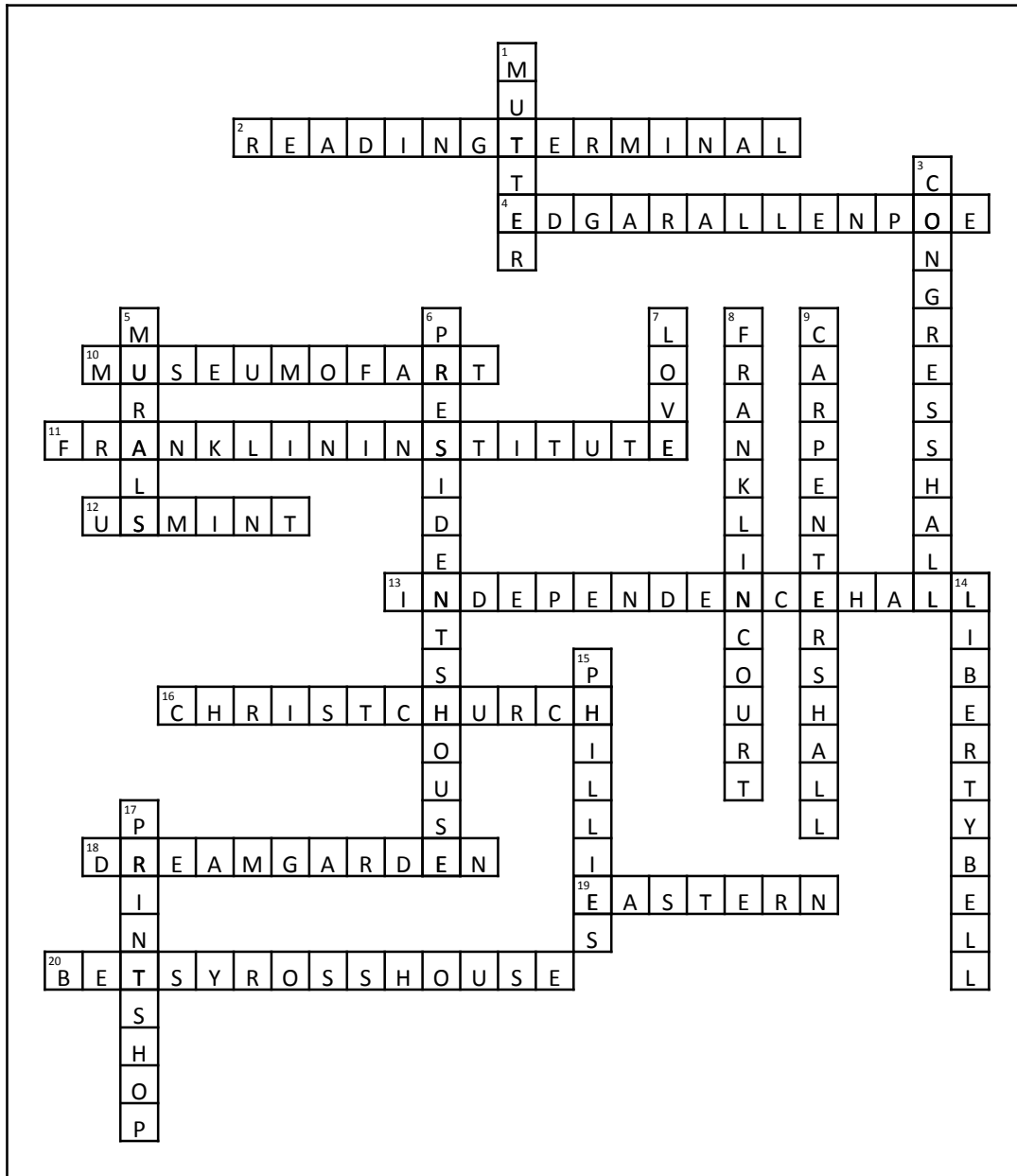
